



## Database of English Learner Texts (DELT)

**DELT** is a database of learner English (written and spoken data at various levels of proficiency). Corpora drawn from DELT are available under the following conditions:

(1) The corpora drawn from DELT are available to be used for non-commercial research and educational purposes; they are available free of charge to all those who are interested in using the corpora for such purposes.

(2) Availability: The corpus data can be accessed at <http://fdz-englisch.univie.ac.at/home/delt-login/>.

(3) All publications on research partly or wholly based on the corpus should acknowledge the source of data as follows:

A copy of the publication should also be sent to the CELT (Centre for English Language Teaching, Spitalgasse 2-4, Hof 8, 1090 Wien, Austria)

(4) No part of the corpus is to be distributed to a third party without specific authorization from CELT. The corpus can only be used by the person signing the licence form and researchers working in close collaboration with him/her or students under his/her supervision, attached to the same institution.

(5) DELT may be updated at any time and without notice. The user is responsible for indicating his/her date of access and regularly checking for updates and modifications which may affect previous research results.

(6) Under no circumstances, including, but not limited to, negligence, shall the creators of DELT or the University be liable for any special or consequential damages that result from the use of or the inability to use the DELT files.

(7) If these Terms of Use are not accepted in full, the user does not have permission to access DELT and therefore should cease using DELT immediately.
